1. Organizer: Institute of Sino-Christian Studies

2. Participating Universities:

Students participating in this program come from 16 universities, which have cooperative relationships with ISCS. The program aims to encourage the graduate students from Mainland China to engage in research on Sino-Christian studies. The affiliated universities include Fudan University, Renmin University of China, Henan University, Zhejiang University, Shandong University, Heilongjiang University, Nankai University, Sun Yat-Sen University of Guangzhou, Peking University, Tsinghua University, Sichuan University, Shannxi Normal University, Central University for Nationalities, Wuhan University and Chinese Academy of Social Science.

3. Selection Process:

- Nomination of outstanding research papers by the professors of 16 universities and research institutes.
- Anonymous review by a committee of referees.
- Each paper is examined by at least two experts in that field.
