The Syriac Renaissance (11th-13th cent.):
A General Introduction and Two Key Representatives of This Period

Description: In the introductory part, we will discuss the time frame of the Syriac Renaissance (when does it start; when does it come to an end and why) and some of the general intellectual orientations: A new way of building up inter-Christian relations; 2. Openness to the world of Islam. In the second part, attention will be paid to two key representatives of this period: Bar Hebraeus (or Bar Ebrovo, 1226-1286), a Syrian-Orthodox scholar and religious leaders and Bar Brikiha (d. 1318), a high-ranking member of the Church of the East.

宇宙「第一因」：當代分析哲學、科學與神學的探討

簡介：宇宙大爆炸是如何產生的？這個問題使許多科學家與哲學家重燃對於傳統卡拉姆 (Kalam) 宇宙論中有關「神存在」和「第一因」問題的興趣。近年來，宇宙學家對大爆炸的前因進行了詳細的討論。本講座探討分析式哲學家 William Lane Craig 和本人近期學術著作 *God and Ultimate Origins* (Springer Nature, 2017) 對以上問題的回答，也回應康德、休謨等哲學家與科學主義者如霍金對於宇宙論的批判。

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
